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How to participate:

Submission is **FREE**, it costs you nothing to submit your images.

You may submit up to 3 images

If your work is selected there will be a participation fee of £25.00 per first image.

If a second image is selected there will be a participation fee of £15.00 per second image.

If a third image is selected there will be a participation fee of £10.00 per third image.

Participation fee 25 years and under £5.00 per image.

If your image/images are selected but participation fees are not received by 17th October 2025 they will not be printed and used in the exhibition.

This fee covers the cost of everything. The Photographers of Shambellie House will print, frame, curate, install and un-install the work at Shambellie House.

Please note that the frames used belong to Shambellie House

Unless otherwise stated images will either be printed 8 x12 or 8x8 inches in size depending on the image.

Photographers can collect a print of their work after the exhibition, photographers must let us know in advance that they wish to collect.

The exhibition may be invited to tour certain venues throughout the region of Dumfries and Galloway from January 2026 onwards, if you have any objections to this, please put a note on your submission.

The submission deadline for this exhibition: Friday 3rd October 2025

- 1. You may submit **up to 3 images** per person for this exhibition. Your photograph should be **300ppi and 3000 Pixels** minimum on the shortest side.
 - Work will be displayed in various sizes depending on the image selected. (You will be asked to resubmit if you do not follow these guidelines)
- 2. Name your image file with **your name** e,g *Firstname-Surname*, If you do not name your files correctly, it could result in your files getting lost or misplaced. Please only use your name, do not include image titles or any other information, this can be added elsewhere in your submission.
- 3. Make sure your images are **JPEG** files. We can only accept jpegs as this is what the printing company that we use requires.
- 4. Please do not include watermarks, borders, signatures or text on your entry, images containing these will be rejected.
- 5. Send your file using WeTransfer which is free to use, to our submission email address entries@shambelliehouse.org Please do not send images via email as this can compress your files.
- 6. If you are selected to participate, you will be notified by email. Those not selected will not be notified. If you have been selected and you wish to participate, this is when you can supply us with additional information such as the title of the photograph and any description. This information will be added to the online gallery for this exhibition.
